Teacher generated reports provide ongoing communication of progress for students grades K-6.</p>	<p>We continue to refine our Health and Wellness emphasis through On the Mat instruction, Through My Actions World Ready Traits and Skills lessons, Out in the Garden school spaces and Farm Lab, and In the Kitchen nutrition exploration. 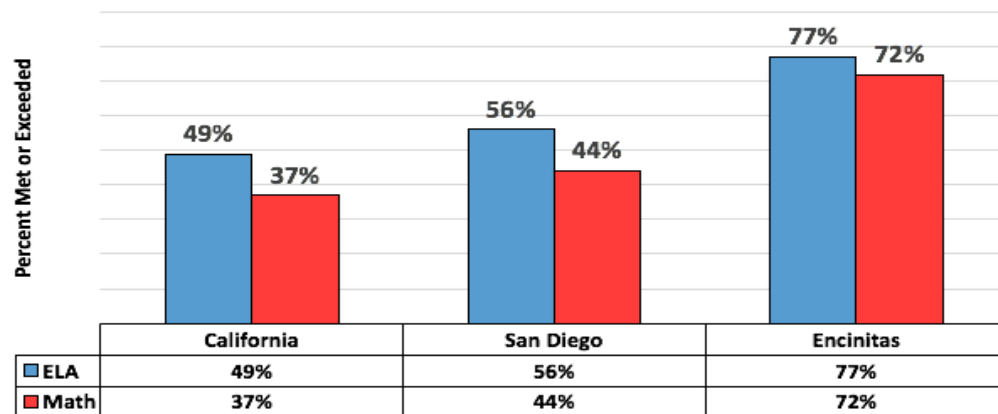
