


- g. Develop a plan for continuity of education. Consider in that plan how to also continue nutrition and other services provided in the regular school setting to establish alternate mechanisms for these services to continue.
- h. Maintain regular communications with the local public health department.

The following steps will be taken for a positive case:

1. In consultation with the local public health department, the principal and superintendent will decide whether school closure versus cleaning and quarantine of exposed persons or other intervention is warranted, including the length of time necessary, based on the risk level within the specific community as determined by the local public health officer.
2. The classroom or office will be closed off where the patient was based and do not use these areas until after cleaning and disinfection. Wait at least 24 hours before cleaning and disinfecting. If 24 hours is not feasible, wait as long as possible.
3. Any additional areas of the school visited by the COVID-19 positive individual may also need to be closed temporarily for cleaning and disinfection.
4. Communication will be done to reach out to any possible exposures
5. If needed communication will be made regarding class or school closures to include outreach to students, parents, teachers, staff, and the community.
6. Information for staff will be shared regarding labor laws, information regarding Disability Insurance, Paid Family Leave and Unemployment Insurance, as applicable to schools. See additional information on government programs supporting sick leave and worker's compensation for COVID-19, including worker's sick leave rights under the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and employee's rights to workers' compensation benefits and presumption of the work-relatedness of COVID-19 pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order N-62-20, while that Order is in effect.
7. Guidance to parents, teachers and staff reminding them of the importance of community physical distancing measures while a school is closed, including discouraging students or staff from gathering elsewhere will be shared.
8. Our short-term closure plan will be implemented. Short Term School Closure Model
9. The district will maintain regular communications with the local public health department.
